# 2018 Club Competition Rules

All entrants must be a financial member of the Maryborough Camera Club Inc. to enter into the Club's monthly competitions and End of Year competitions.

New members will be allocated to either A or B Grade depending on their expertise upon joining the Club.

B Grade workers will be obliged to move to A Grade upon accumulating the highest points scored for the current vear and at the discretion of the Committee.

## **Monthly Competitions**

### **General**

Be aware of new DPI sizing for 2018.

- All entries:
  - a) may have been submitted in a previous club competition BUT not received an Honour or Merit
  - b) must be the work of the author, including any added elements.
- Members may only submit entries in their relevant club grade/section.
- Judging
  - Wherever possible, digital entries will be sent to PSQ accredited judges for judging and comment. These will be viewed at a subsequent critique meeting.
  - Print judging will be conducted on the night of the competition. Wherever possible, PSQ accredited judges will be invited for these events.
- Awards
  - Judges may award an image an HONOUR or a MERIT. There will be no limit to the number of awards the judge may present in each section.
- Points will be allocated to images in each section as follows:-

Honour 4 points Merit 3 points

Entry 1 point will be allocated for each image entered by a member.

- File Naming
  - Correct file naming ensures that your entry appears in the correct section. It also makes the job
    of the recording officer much easier and far less time consuming.
  - Prints and DPI Images should be named using the following format.

GradeSection-MonthYear-Title-Competitor's Initials

#### Eq BO-0218-Sunset-BJS

This indicates an entry in the **B** grade **O**pen section, in February 2018. It is titled **Sunset** and was entered by **B**rian **J**ames **S**mith.

(Please use a hyphen (-) NOT an underscore (\_) in file names.

- All image titles should be restricted to 15 characters maximum
- Prints should be labelled on the back so that the orientation of the print is correct when reading the label. An arrow pointing to the top of the print is also useful.

- Maximum image dimensions:- Width 1920 pixels. Height 1080 pixels (NOTE: new sizing)
- Maximum file size:- 500kb (NOTE: new sizing)

# **End of Year Competition**

Images/prints submitted for the End Of Year Competitions must have been entered into the Club's monthly competitions during the current calendar year.

The End of Year Competition will be judged and announced at the December competition meeting.

Members are eligible to submit up to 3 entries in each of the following sections:A Grade:- (i) Open Print & (ii) Set Subject Print, **and** (iii) Open DPI & (iv)Set Subject DPI
B Grade:- (i) Open Print & (ii) Set Subject Print, **and** (iii) Open DPI & (iv)Set Subject DPI

Overall points gained during the year (up to November) will accumulate and the member with the most points will be awarded the *Maximum Overall Points A Grade or Maximum Overall Points B Grade*.
