

MARYBOROUGH CAMERA CLUB – SET SUBJECTS 2019

Month	Format	Subject	Definition
FEBRUARY	PRINT	BOOK/S	May include a collection of books, a whole book or part of a book.
MARCH	DPI	BLACK & WHITE	Open subject. Black & White. No toning or selective colouring.
APRIL	PRINT	CANE & CATTLE (FC SHOW THEME)	Main subject to portray Cane and/or Cattle industry.
MAY	DPI	NATURE	APS definition of nature. Story telling value is more important than pictorial quality. Images can be edited by cropping or removal of dust spots and noise and enhanced to improve presentation, without changing the content of the original scene. No removing or adding of image elements through cloning or healing. Image not to contain evidence of man unless integral to the story of the image. Nature may include non-living things; fossils, environments, weather events. Images of an animal and its prey are acceptable; however images where the main subject is a dead animal are not acceptable. Animals and plants must be native, not introduced or cultivated varieties. Animals may be in wildlife parks, zoos or controlled conditions.
JUNE	PRINT	SUPERSTITION	Create an image to represent a common superstition. eg lucky horseshoe. Try to have title help identify superstition. Does not include proverbs eg “A stitch in time saves nine.”
JULY	DPI	ODD NUMBERS (Tewantin Shield Subject)	There needs to be an odd number of subjects or key elements eg 3 flowers
AUGUST	PRINT	ENVIRONMENTAL TRASH	Discarded man-made objects, or parts thereof, found within the natural environment.
SEPTEMBER	DPI	GERIATRIC	This is a “Person/People” topic, just specifically older people. May be a portrait shot or subject may be engaged in an activity.
OCTOBER	PRINT	FLOWER, FLOWERS, or PART THEREOF	May be single, multiple of just a part of a flower.
NOVEMBER	DPI	LANDSCAPE	Subject is to be land based - not to include seascape or cityscape. Lakes, rivers etc may be a part of the image.
DECEMBER	DPI & PRINT	END OF YEAR	Your best 3 2019 images from both DPI & Print entries in both OPEN and SET SUBJECT categories. (Max 6 DPI entries and 6 PRINT entries.)
